But on the passing of time as to the question you posed, you should know that the Judge decided to grant an award of attorney's fees on February 3, 2010. In about 30 hours, it will be 9 months.

The judge asked for more information before deciding the amount of the award, all of which had been submitted to his Honor by both sides by March 20, 2010, more than 7 months ago. Most decisions are rendered in fewer than 7 months.
